54 | [((laughs))]
55 | K: [Yeah.

59 | body and the type of person, some people are just like let's go get tattoos!

65 | H: [Or just

69 | I'm like [oh, I wanna look at this every day-
70 | H: [You could always get it lasered off.
71 | A: But then it just looks like crap, you got this pink shit all over you.
72 | H: Pink shit?
73 | K: ()
74 | H: I've never se[en that.
75 | A: [The scar tissue when you remove it is really ugly I think.
76 | H: Oh..well ju[st get a-
77 | K: [Well- just like skin yourself where the tattoo is, and then it'll
78 | just grow back! [((H laughs))]
79 | A: Ok.
80 | K: Just like- just like a battle wound! [((laughter))]
81 | A: Make up some elaborate story.
82 | K: Just have like a huge scab right there [((A laughs))]
83 | A: My mom got a tattoo like on her middle toe-
84 | H: What?
85 | K: [Her middle toe?
86 | A: [So silly, and then she got like a little flower on- like- like right there on
87 | her toe-
88 | K: [That's-
89 | H: [βDid she go to Naropa? [((laughter))]
90 | A: No, did you go to Naropa?
91 | H: Well she's a massage therapist right?
92 | A: Oh, yeah, she is.

93 | H: [Yeah yeah
94 | A: [And she [has-
95 | K: [is she Buddhist as well?
96 | A: no, but that would be perfect for Naropa!
97 | K: I was gonna say, cuz we- me and my roommate freshman year went down
98 | there cuz we lived by College Inn so it was right down the street, but- we
99 | went down there, and we were just like making fun of how it was a

158 A: [smear
159 H: But you really don't know-
160 A: You [don't!
161 H: [Unless you- unless you like Google it-
162 K: Yeah.
163 H: But Google could be wrong.
164 A: Google can lie.
165 K: Google can't lie. Just like Wikipedia. It can never lie.
166 A: Dude I was telling my brother something last night and he was like nope, I

168 K: [(laughs)) Oh What?
169 H: What?

193 | K: For the most part.

195 | your ears pierced, He would-
196 | [((laughter))]
197 | H: Who says that?
198 | K: No, it's not- it's not religiously backed, it's just most of like guys or girls
199 | just don't know how to like-
200 | A: [Pierce?
201 | K: [complement themselves with jewelry. That's why I hate jewelry, is cuz
202 | most people just go [wrong-
203 | H: [How bout your glasses, that's kinda like jewelry.
204 | K: [((laughs))] What!
205 | H: It's an accessory.
206 | A: [It is- (
207 | K: [It's not an accessory, it's a ne[cessity!
208 | H: [You could just have contacts.
209 | A: I've never heard someone say that about jewelry.
210 | K: That's too much money.
211 | H: [((laughs))] I know!
212 | K: I just hate jewelry.
213 | A: So what, you knockin on my necklace right now?
214 | K: Yes.
215 | A: Screw you, this is my favorite necklace!
216 | H: Is that some uh see- like- [Seattle ()?
217 | K: [Is it for Seattle?
218 | A: No, it's like the twelve auspicious signs of Buddhism, I got it from
219 | Naropa.
220 | H: Ohhh [((K laughs))]
221 | A: That's a lie actually [((laughs))]
222 | K: I see the connection here. I see the connection.
223 | [((laughter))]
224 | A: Yeah.
225 | H: What are the twelve auspicious signs?
226 | A: No idea! But this is what they look like!
227 | [((laughter))]
228 | K: There ya go!
229 | H: Sounds like the Zodiac or somethin.
230 | K: Yeah. [That's what I-

231 | A: [Yeah, it's- [I think it's-
232 | K: [That's what I thought.
233 | A: Kinda related.
234 | K: Twelve.
235 | A: Yeah, we could Google it.
236 | [((laughter))]
237 | H: Google it!
238 | K: And it won't lie to you.
239 | A: Yeah.
240 | H: They know a lot about the Chinese one, so.
241 | K: What?
242 | A: What?
243 | [((laughter))]
244 | H: Anyway-
245 | K: Anyways. Yeah. I hate jewelry.
246 | A: So weird.
247 | H: That is really weird.
248 | K: For- for like 99% of the time, people can't get it right.
249 | A: Do you- [you don't have any jewelry- ()
250 | H: [So-
251 | K: Exactly.
252 | H: Well I don't really eith[er. What about a watch?=
253 | A: [()
254 | H: = [That's jewelry.
255 | K: [A watch is- that- that's jewelry, but you have to get it right. [That's
256 | what I'm saying-
257 | H: [What do you
258 | mean get it right?
259 | K: [It doesn't
260 | matter what it is, you have to get it right, it has to- [((H laughs))] jewelry
261 | has to complement-
262 | A: Do you get it right? Well you don't wear it, cuz you know you're not
263 | gonna get it right.
264 | K: I always get it right, I just don't like a watch cuz it's extra weight and I
265 | never use it for-
266 | [((H laughs))]
267 | A: Yeah, plus- plus your phone has like a clock on it, so [I you don't need it.
268 | K: [Exactly. That's
269 | why=
270 | H: [I hate jewelry too-
271 | K: =[I can't tell what time it is if my phone dies cuz- I don't have a-
272 | [((laughs))] time teller! [((A laughs))] I'm not a "watch" [person.
273 | H: [A timepiece?
274 | K: Yes, there ya go. But anyways, the point is, most people can't get it right.
275 | H: But what do you mean by getting it right?
276 | K: Like, it has to complement you, not just- you just- you don't wanna wear it

277 cuz you wanna like show off how much money you dropped on it or
278 [something.
279 | A: [What about like an eyebrow ring? (((laughs)))]
280 | K: I hate those, oh my God. (((A laughs))) It's just- just like- no.
281 | A: I saw a girl in Seattle who had her- her this thing was pierced, and her- her
282 eyebrows were pierced.
283 | K: I- it's just such a turnoff.
284 | A: [I just wanna- keep it clean
285 | H: [Really?
286 | K: Yeah.
287 | A: Or like people with [their nose-
288 | H: [Yeah...
289 | A: One thing that annoys me is the nose- nose piercings, when people like
290 play with the- the nose ring, and it looks like they're picking their nose.
291 Like all the- and- [I mean they practically are! (((H laughs)))]
292 | H: [I don't really notice that ((laughs))

295 | H: My sister's got one-
296 | A: [Well- you don't like any jewelry! ((laughs))

300 | A: [I know!
301 | H: Cuz your opinion's very different from a lotta other people.
302 | K: I- I'm just saying I'm not opposed to it, it's just...99% of the time, it just
303 does not work out. (((voices outside door, conversation does not halt)))
304 because-
305 | H: I think jewelry is about expressing the way- like who you are.
306 | K: True, but it should be expressed in a way that complements you rather than
307 you're just wearing it because you- can. Or... you...want to. Well, I
308 guess...well if you want to, that's ok [cuz you don't-
309 | A: [Well I only wear jewelry that
310 complements me and I always get it right. (((laughter)))]
311 | K: Well...miss perfect! ((A laughs))
312 | H: Is she the 1%?
313 | A: Of course. (((laughter))}
314 | K: [Sure. No comment! (((laughter))]
315 | A: I forgot this was recorded! ((laughs)) Um, no, I don't know. I- I mean I
316 agree, I see a lotta people especially like some older people, they wear like
317 a lot of gaudy jewelry, like big gold necklaces and then big gold [earrings-
318 | H: [Maybe

 324 | A: [Do you guys think it- it's uh

 326 | H: What kinda [bracelet?
 327 | K: [It depends, [see that's- that's the thing.
 328 | A: [any kind. I just think it's weird when they wear
 329 | bracelets.
 330 | K: Yeah.
 331 | H: Like on the OC where they have those [like-
 332 | K: [Like the Livestrong bracelets? Or
 333 | like legitimate bracelets?
 334 | A: [The Livestrong, I guess like
 335 | whatever, it's- it's not really [jewelry-
 336 | H: [For cancer! (((K laughs))]
 337 | K: For [cancer!
 338 | A: [For cancer, yeah...
 339 | K: But like, [legitimate-
 340 | A: [But like the leather ones, like the hemp ones, and they'd have
 341 | like a bunch on I just think that's so weird.
 342 | K: Oh, see that- that could actually work, like I kind of like that.
 343 | H: I used to wear [one of those.
 344 | K: [Depending on the guy.
 345 | A: The who doesn't like jewelry (((laughter))]
 346 | K: I said- No no no that's what I'm saying, I don't like jewelry because so
 347 | many people have gotten it wrong.
 348 | A: Mmhmm.
 349 | K: [But it's not-
 350 | H: [But the hemp isn't wrong.
 351 | K: Well it's not- [it's not about whether or not-
 352 | A: [Ok, what about in Colorado, do the girls do the rooster
 353 | feather thing?
 354 | K: Oh my God, I- I don't get it.
 355 | A: I know, he hates that too, ok-
 356 | K: [I don't hate it-
 357 | H: [How do you hate it though? I don't hate it-
 358 | K: I don't hate it, I just don't get it. [Why would you-
 359 | A: [It's cool, it looks cool! (((laughter))]
 360 | K: [Is it cool?
 361 | H: [It looks cool! ((laughs))
 362 | K: It's like- no, it's like you're-
 363 | A: ((laughs)) you're like is it really?
 364 | K: You're- it's- it's like you're looking at someone and then just like boom! It
 365 | just like pops from it, so your attention just [goes to their head-
 366 | A: [Well they- they put it like
 367 | kinda like underneath the hair so that you don't see it [right away.
 368 | K: [Not- not 90% of

369 [people-
370 H: [It's like a fake highlight almost.
371 K: Yeah, [yeah exactly!
372 A: [Yeah, exactly!
373 H: Why don't you just put paper in your hair? [((laughter))]
374 A: Would that work?
375 H: Like- like print out a picture of a feather ((K laughs)) and then put it over
376 there? [((laughter))]
377 K: Put it over there! [((laughter)) I don't even know how to do it, do they
378 like bond the feather onto your [hair or something?
379 A: [No, there's like this jaw clip and they put
380 glue [on it-
381 H: [What?
382 A: And then they clip it to your hair ((H laughs)) and it just like stays there
383 you can like brush it and everything.
384 K: I feel like that's not healthy for your hair.
385 H: Why not?
386 K: Cuz it's like-
387 H: You're gonna go bald one day!
388 A: It 's kind of- when you take it out, [your hair will come out.
389 K: [It's kinda- it's kinda like- it's kinda
390 like getting cornrows.
391 H: Is that bad?
392 K: Yeah it's really bad for your hair, cuz it keeps pulling it.
393 A: Well this goes really well with the next topic, which is cosmetic surgery,
394 would you guys get hair implants? [((H laughs))]
395 H: Hair wha?
396 A: Hair implants?
397 K: Sh- [sure
398 H: [Like plugs, like-

402 H: And it grew?
403 K: I know, I have it right now.
404 H: What?
405 A: [((laughs)) He's the 1% who does it right!
406 [((laughter))]
407 H: No you don't! You got a haircut! [((K laughs))]
408 A: Well-
409 K: You can get a haircut with [that.
410 A: [Well- yeah cuz it's an implant- don't they like
411 remove hair from like your arm?
412 K: Yeah yeah [ye ye.
413 H: [Oh they graft your hair?
414 K: Yeah, kind of [((A laughs))]

417 | lawn-
418 | A: Dude, the images in my mind are really [disturbing.
419 | H: [Wait, really?
420 | K: Yeah.
421 | H: You- you have it?
422 | K: I don't have that!
423 | [(laughter)]
424 | A: It was a joke, it was a joke!
425 | K: You're clearly taking this too seriously!
426 | [(laughter)]
427 | H: No, I thought, like, that's- that makes sense, why don't people do that,
428 | you know?
429 | K: They do do that! Like-
430 | A: Especially if you're- if you're like 70's age and [you're already going
431 | bald, you would definitely wanna fix that.
432 | K: [You're-- yeah. [Exactly
433 | H: [Or just
434 | go bald.
435 | K: Or just go bald?
436 | H: Like [full on bald.
437 | A: [Yeah, like just shave [your head bald.
438 | K: [Like yeah, cuz I've had like- I've had like a
439 | bunch of teachers who just shave their head cuz, like, when you- even if
440 | you shave, you know how you can kinda faintly see where the hair is
441 | supposed to be?
442 | A: [Mhmm
443 | H: [Mhmm.
444 | K: Kinda like the stubble? Well there was like, this huge like [(laughter)]
445 | spot that was just like shiny, and then there was like hair around it, and I
446 | was like oh, I see why you're shaving your head. [(laughs)]
447 | A: Yep, that makes sense. I always feel bad for dudes cuz they go bald, it's
448 | always-
449 | H: Wo[men go bald too though.
450 | K: [I know- I know chicks who go bald.
451 | H: [I thought my Grandma was doing it.
452 | A: [Well I'm not gonna go bald!
453 | [(laughter)]

455 | H: [20 years?

458 | know like-

461 K: [Well-

463 H: [You're right.
464 A: [It's just a lotta work! [(laughs)]]
465 H: It's like shampoo, no cost.
466 A: [Yeah!
467 [(laughter)]]
468 K: [When I'm 80 I probably won't even wanna live anymore! Probably just
469 like- jump out [of a plane [(laughs)]]
470 H: []
471 [(laughter)]]
472 K: But I mean, apart from hair, like most people get like nose jobs.
473 A: Yeah.
474 K: I think that's- that's cool, it's all good.
475 H: Who's that girl on The Hills, Heidi?
476 A: So weird! Oh-
477 K: Who?
478 H: Heidi [uh-
479 A: [She messed herself up man!

481 A: She was really [cute before!

483 A: Now she's just like-
484 H: Now she's- [bloated...
485 A: [Barbie got bloated!
486 K: Who?

490 A: Montag.
491 H: Yeah, Montag. She got [married in Mexico to that guy Spencer?
492 K: [Sounds familiar
493 A: That guy's an idiot! [(H laughs)]]
494 K: I don't- I-
495 H: You don't follow the hills?! [Come on, man [(laughter)]]
496 K: [No, clearly not!
497 A: Clearly he does [(H&K laugh)] Oh I got Laguna Beach this summer at
498 Goodwill for like two dollars and I tried to watch it, such a- if you guys
499 [watch it-
500 H: [Was it on VHS?
501 A: No, it was on DVD actually [(H laughs)]]
502 K: []
503 H: [For two [bucks!
504 A: [Such a train wreck, yeah!
505 H: Laguna [Hills...
506 K: [Sounds like [a record!

507 A: [()]
508 H: Oh Laguna Beach, [is that with um-
509 A: [Yeah.
510 H: That's with like- that's with Heidi right?
511 A: She- uh, no, that's with Lauren, who's like Heidi's [friend or something.
512 H: [And then LC and-
513 A: Yeah.
514 H: Is that the one? And Audrina...
515 A: Oh [you know you like watch it, and you really start to get into it=
516 H: [And Audrey ()
517 A: =and then you're like oh God what am I doing? Oh wait, oh, no, what am I
518 doing?
519 [((laughter))]
520 A: This is silly! Oh well.
521 K: But- Yeah. I mean, it's good if you don't fuck it up.
522 H: The jewelry, is that what you're [talking about?
523 A: [I feel like we could ask Kumar anything=
524 K: [No, the cosmetic surgery.
525 ((laughs))
526 A: =[and he'd be like it's good as long as you don't mess it up. [((H laughs))
527 No but I- I think some people who get it done I- it's ok, like- like I had a
528 friend who couldn't go swimming cuz she was just so self-conscious and
529 she got cosmetic surgery done on her body, and now she's like-[good,
530 confident and=
531 H: [That's cool.
532 A: =Yeah!
533 K: Well- [well-
534 A: [She didn't go [like over the top, it's not just all over.
535 K: [Do you mean like lipo?
536 A: No, she got a boob job.
537 K: Oh, ok, ok, cuz I don't consider lipo [cosmetic surgery.
538 A: [You don't consider that cosmetic
539 [surgery?
540 H: [That'd be [cosmetic.
541 K: [It's kind- it's- I consider that more for health reasons rather
542 [than cosmetic reasons.
543 H: [That's true. [There's a- there's a fine line-
544 A: [No, that's cosmetic surgery too.
545 K: [I guess, but it's like-
546 H: [But, what if you're- about to die from too much fat?
547 K: Yeah.
548 A: Well, then you get a gastric bypass.
549 K: ((laughs)) Get like a stent in your vein so that you don't like-
550 H: What?
551 A: That's- [that's where they clamp your stomach [so (it's small)
552 K: [Just get stents?

553 | H: [Yeah, they like staple it
554 | [up.
555 | A: [That's for health [reasons.
556 | K: [Well or that-
557 | H: [Well-
558 | K: [or you get a stent if you get like a heart attack, they put stents in your
559 | arteries so that it keeps the arteries [from opening.
560 | H: [oh
561 | A: [But you have to do it right!
562 | [((laughter))]
563 | K: ((laughs)) You have to do it right, so-
564 | H: That's the right way to do it!
565 | K: ((laughs)) or else you're gonna get- you're gonna get another heart attack!
