- Other divisions seem to be including more papers within a single panel (9 papers within panels); LSI kept limit to 5 papers per panel this year
- Discussion on pool of available reviewers and opportunities to review if not submitting or attending the conference
 - Sending out a message (e.g., Google form) to all LSI members calling for volunteers to review papers (and/or chair sessions)
 - Alternative approach is requiring those who submit to also review (as in ICA)
 - Topic to raise in NCA assembly. Submitters and members should have the opportunity to review and participate.
